STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (C)

Standard Operating Procedure to be followed for appointment of Professors/Associate Professors on regular basis at the University Campus and its Regional Campuses and Principals in Constituent Colleges and University Colleges

- 1. Online applications on the prescribed format shall be invited from the eligible candidates for various posts of Professors/Associate Professors/Principals through an open advertisement to be published in the newspapers as well as posted on the University website (www.gndu.ac.in).
- 2. The applicants will be required to fill up the Academic/Research Score Proforma (as per Annexure-V) and Score Card Proforma (as per Annexure-VI) duly approved by the Syndicate, available at www.gndu.ac.in.
- 3. The scrutiny committee to scrutinize the applications will consist of Director Research as a Chairperson, Dean Faculty and Board of Control of the Concerned Department for the posts of Professors and Associate Professors. In case of Principals the scrutiny committee will consist of Dean, College Development Council as Chairperson, Registrar, Director Research, Dean Faculty and Board of Control of the Department of concerned discipline.
- 4. After receipt of applications, scrutiny of the applications shall be done by the scrutiny committee to check the documents as well as eligibility of the applicants.
- 5. The scrutiny committee will verify the marks claimed by the applicant in the Score Card and prepare a merit list based on the Score Card.
- 6. The scrutiny committee shall also send recommendation to invite 6 candidates for each first vacancy and 3 candidates for every additional vacancy (as approved by the Syndicate) for the interview as per the order of the merit list.
- 7. The constitution of the Selection Committee shall be as per UGC Regulations 2018 under Clause 5.1 (II & III) and 5.1 (VIII) for appointments on regular basis. At least four members, including two external subject experts shall constitute the quorum.
- 8. The final Selection of the candidates will be made by the Selection Committee considering the following parameters(as per Annexure VII):
 - a) Academic Background 20% weightage [as per score card attached at Annexure VI, the marks secured by applicant as per annexure-VI will be calculated for 20% weightage of 100 marks by applying the formula = <u>Marks secured</u> x 20 Maximum marks (100)
 - b) Research Performance 40% weightage [as per Annexure VII]
 - c) Assessment of domain knowledge by outside experts 20% weightage [as per Annexure VII]
 - d) Interview 20% weightage [as per Annexure VII]
- 9. The assessment of the research performance (for 40% weightage-based on the five best publications submitted by the applicant) and domain knowledge (for 20% weightage - in a simulated class room set up) of the shortlisted applicants will be done by external subject experts.
